 Academic Year 2022-2023**

The University of Crete Medical School announces a new call for applications for the Graduate Program “*The Molecular Basis of Human Diseases*”, academic year 2022-2023. Courses will start in the Fall of 2022 and a Master’s degree will be awarded after the successful completion of four (4) academic semesters.

The Program accepts a maximum number of 15 students each year. Eligible applicants should hold an MD or BSc degree from Departments of Schools of Health Sciences (Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy) or Biological Sciences (Biology, Molecular Biology, Genetic Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Chemistry).

Fees: The Graduate Program has no fees.

The selection of applicants is based on the following criteria:

- Grade of BSc or MD degree
- Grades in undergraduate courses that are relevant to the Program
- Perfect knowledge of the English language (B2 level or higher is required)
- Letters of recommendation
- A letter of intent
- Interview
- Any additional document in support of the Application

Interested applicants should submit the following documents **electronically only** to the website <https://postgrad.cict.uoc.gr>:

- Application Form (applicants should register to the web site before submitting the application and all supporting documents)
- A recent CV
- Certified copy of the BSc or MD degree
 Applicants that hold a BSc or MD degree from a non-Greek University should also submit a certificate of equivalence and/or correspondence of these degrees from the National Academic Recognition Information Center (NARIC ΔΟΑΤΑΠ) of Greece upon registration.
- Transcript of Records
- Any publications in scientific journals or presentations in scientific meetings (pdf)
- Certificate of the English language (B2 level as a minimal requirement)
- 2 letters of recommendation (sent directly by the recommender, not the applicant, to the application platform <https://postgrad.cict.uoc.gr>)
- Any additional documents in support of the application
- Photo

The deadline for the submission of the applications and the supporting documents is
April 15, 2022

The interviews will take place **in the period of May 2022**. The exact dates will be announced later by e-mail to all applicants.
