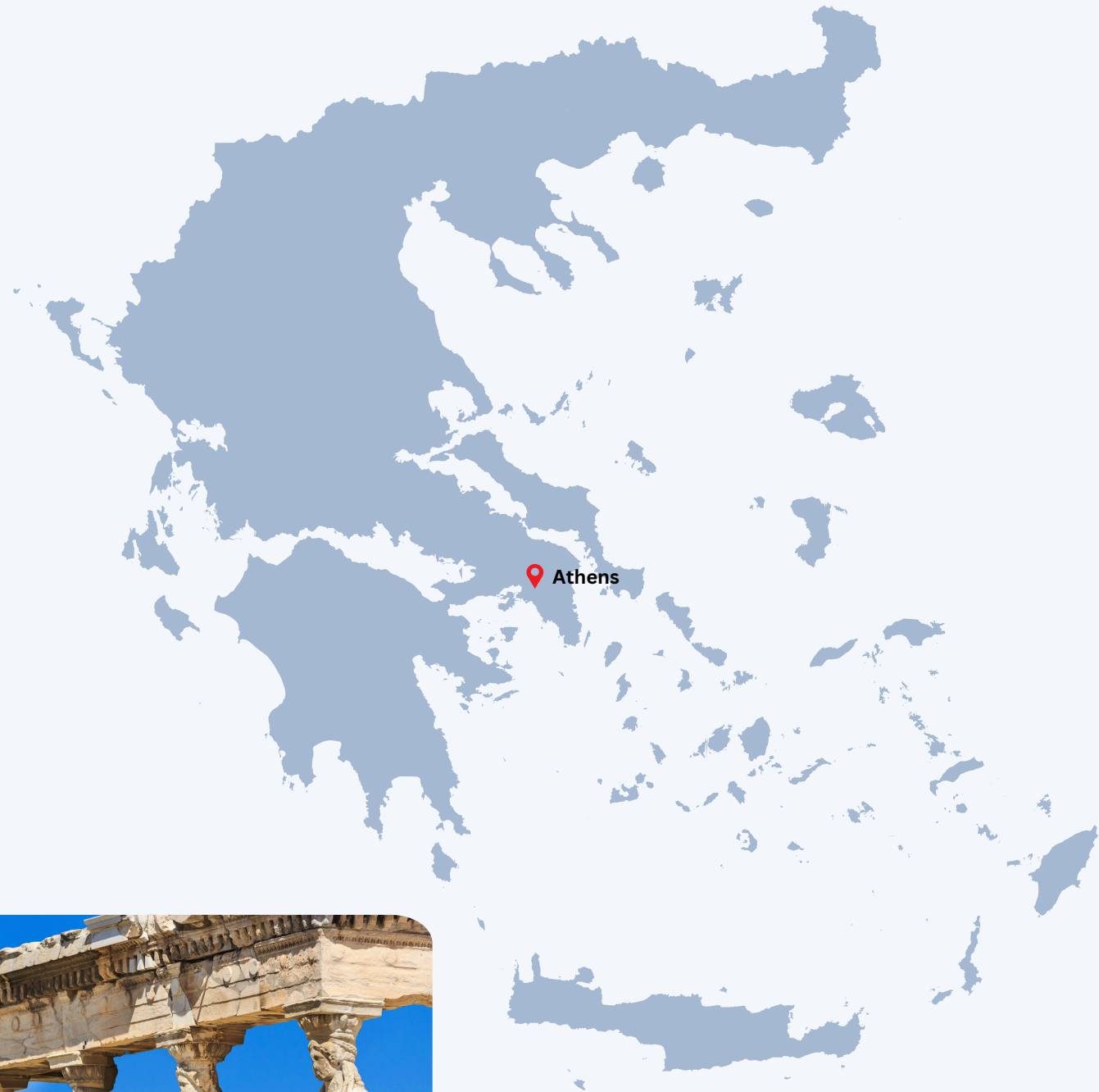

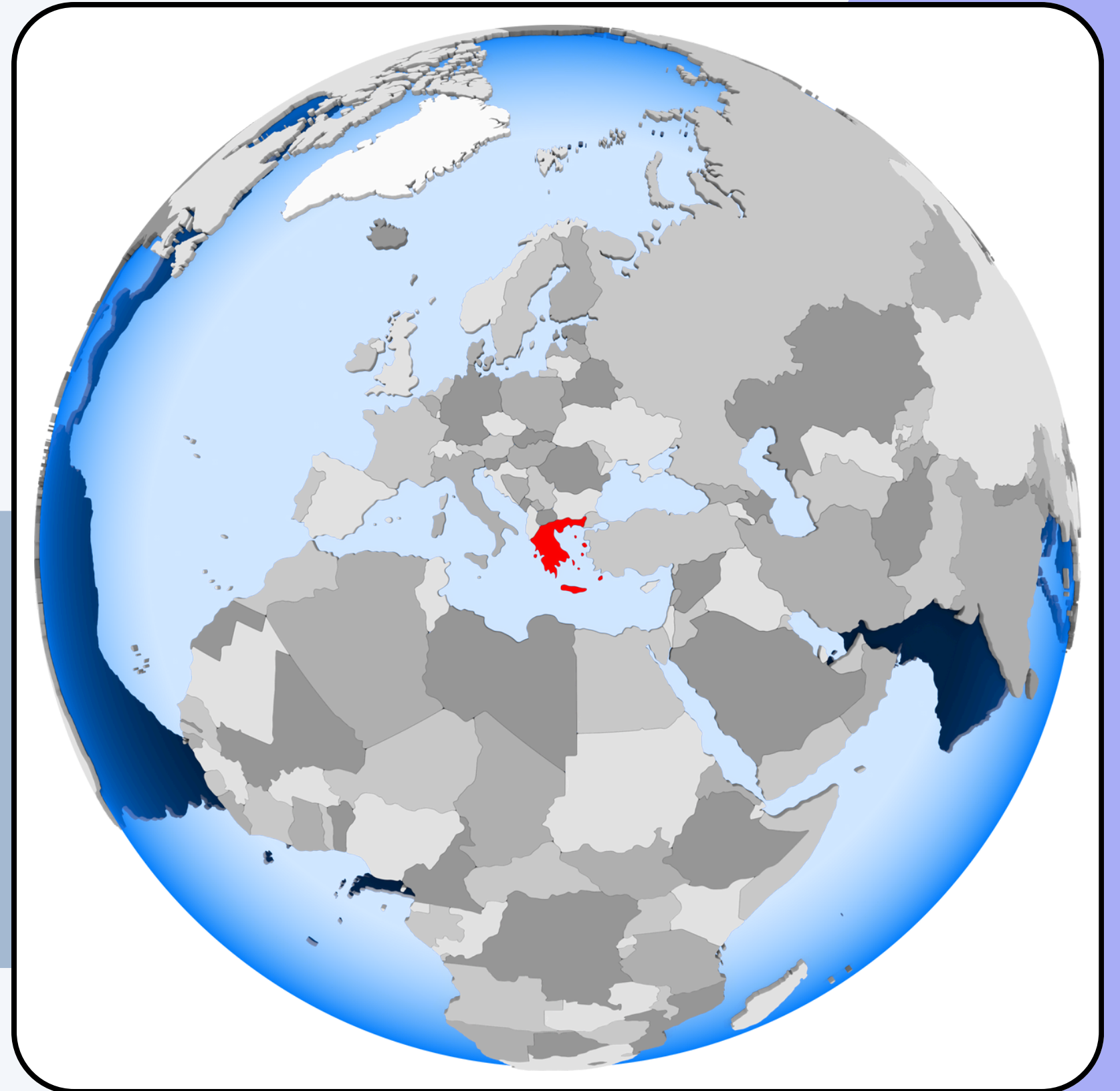


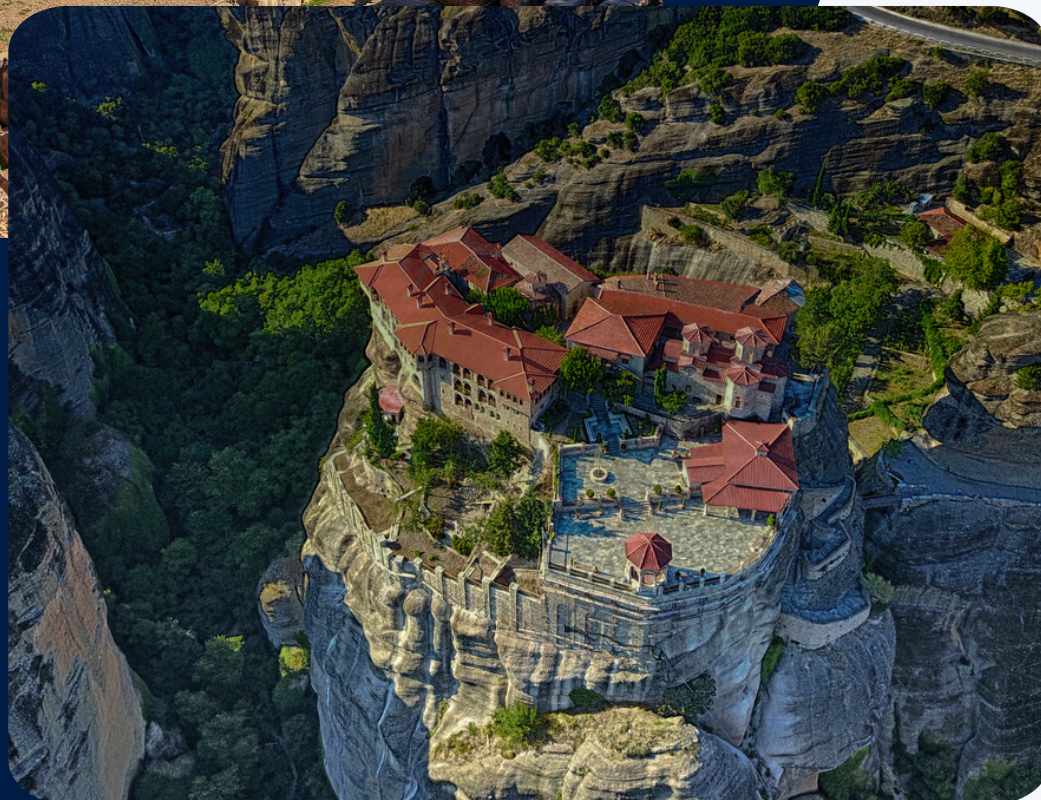




Greece at a glance

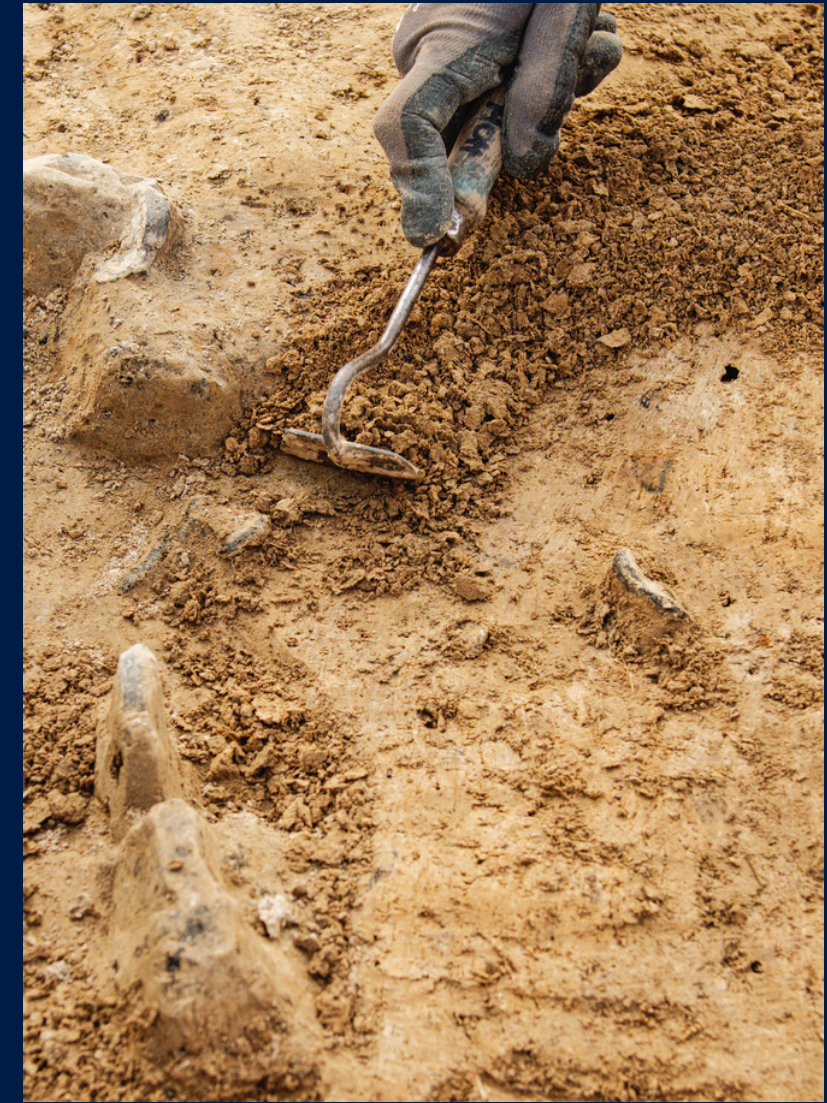
Greek universities can offer

- Inter – university joint programs
 - Based on MoUs among Universities
 - Bachelors and Masters programs
- Short term, summer and winter study-abroad programs
 - faculty-led courses from other universities
 - faculty-led courses from host (Greek) universities, with recognition of credits, based on corresponding MoUs
- Semester-long courses, based on joint programs (e.g. 2+ 2 basis)
- Internships
- Degree programs (BSc, MSc, PhD)



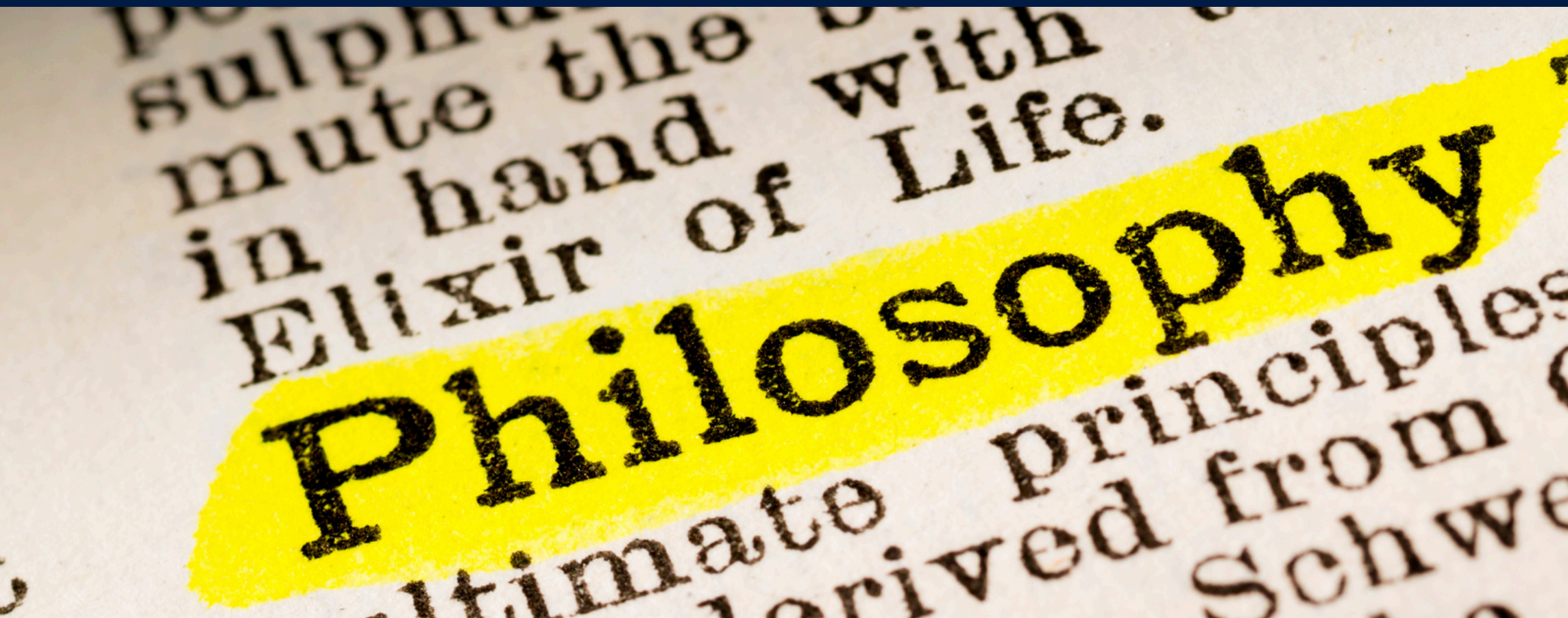
